Notes to the balance sheet and income statement

I-1 - Significant accounting policies

BNP Paribas Covered Bonds prepares its financial statements in accordance with French generally accepted accounting principles for credit institutions, using the historical cost convention.

Significant accounting policies are as follows:

1. Other long-term investments

a) Definition

This item comprises a membership certificate related to the French deposit protection scheme provided for in article L.312-4 of the French Monetary and Financial Code.

b) Cost

The membership certificate is recognised in an amount equal to the contribution to the deposit protection scheme.

c) Revenue recognition

Interest is recognised on an accrual basis calculated by reference to the average yield on 10-year government bonds.

2. Receivables

Receivables are recognised at amortised cost.

3. Debt securities

Debt securities issued are recognised at amortised cost. The issue premium is deferred over the term of the securities.

4. Recognition of financial income and expense

Interest income and commission income treated as interest income is recognised on an accrual basis. Fees received in consideration for services provided are recognised when earned.

I-2 - General information

As collateral for its covered bond issues, BNP Paribas S.A. has provided BNP Paribas Covered Bonds with a pool of mortgage loans totalling €21,771,874,959 (twenty-one billion seven hundred and seventy one million, eight hundred and seventy-four thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine euros) at 31 December 2008.

The pool has been used for outstanding issues in an amount of $\le 16,397,000,000$ (sixteen billion, three hundred and ninety-seven million euros).

To the Shareholders,

In compliance with the assignment entrusted to us by your Shareholders' Meeting, we hereby report to you, for the year ended 31 December 2008, on:

- the audit of the accompanying financial statements of BNP PARIBAS HOME LOAN COVERED BONDS SA (formerly BNP PARIBAS COVERED BONDS SA),
- the justification of our assessments,
- the specific verifications and information required by law.

These financial statements have been approved by the Management Board. Our role is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

I - Opinion on the financial statements

We conducted our audit in accordance with professional standards applicable in France. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the annual financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit consists of examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.

In our opinion, the financial statements give a true and fair view of the company's financial position and its assets and liabilities as at 31 December 2008, and of the results of its operations for the year then ended in accordance with the accounting rules and principles applicable in France.

We draw your attention to the reasons presented in the management report explaining that your company does not provide any information relating to remuneration and benefits granted by the controlling entity to corporate officers of your company who are not also corporate officers of the controlling entity.
